Florida Jet Expands Fleet with Purchase of Learjet 55

Fort Lauderdale, Florida (March 20, 2007) – Florida Jet Service, a premier aircraft charter provider, announced today the addition of Learjet 55, serial number 144 to their charter fleet.

As is standard at Florida Jet, the aircraft, registered as N178AM, underwent a complete interior and exterior refurbishment after its purchase in March 2007. The well appointed, seven passenger, stand-up cabin includes a flat screen TV, DVD and CD sound system, XM radio, Airshow, satellite phone, an enclosed lavatory and fully berthable seats for passenger comfort. The aircraft is also RVSM, TCAS and TAWS equipped.

Florida Jet, which built its successful charter business with a fleet of Learjets, has also recently added a Gulfstream III and a Eurocopter EC 130B4, but the Learjet 55s continue to be the mainstay of their fleet.
